



Minutes of Meeting

A stakeholder meeting cum consultation regarding issues related to handling, disposal and monitoring of ETP Sludge and MEE Salt generated from textile process houses at Bhilwara was held under the chairmanship of Member Secretary, RSPCB, Jaipur by VC Mode on 15.04.2026. The meeting was attended by the following:

- 1) ACEE (Planning), RSPCB (Through VC)
- 2) ACEE (CETP), RSPCB (Through VC)
- 3) GIC (Textile), RSPCB (Through VC)
- 4) Regional Officer, RSPCB, Bhilwara
- 5) Representatives from Textile Process Houses, Cement Plants, and Pre-processing plants

At the outset, the Regional Officer welcomed the Member Secretary and other participants. Subsequently, the following agendas were discussed:

- 1) Issues related to manifest uploading on the Process House Monitoring Portal.
- 2) Recording of moisture content details during waste receipt.
- 3) Low collection frequency and vehicle maintenance issues.
- 4) Mixing of MEE Salt with sludge and monsoon storage challenges.
- 5) Authorization for disposal through pre-processing units.

Agenda items were discussed in detail and after deliberation, the following directions were issued:

Manifest Compliance: All vendors of Sludge and MEE salt must ensure regular and mandatory uploading of manifests along with moisture content details on the portal developed for the monitoring of the same. (Action by: All Vendors/Industries)





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Moisture Monitoring: Co-processing units shall mandatorily record and report moisture content at the time of receipt of sludge in their premises. Further, sludge may not be accepted, if moisture content is not within prescribed limits in accordance with Head Office Order dated 17.12.2021. (Action by: Co-processing units)

Installation of Sludge Dryers: All textile process houses shall have adequate infrastructure/arrangements to achieve prescribed moisture limits i.e., less than 10%; within a period of one year, meanwhile the unit shall submit timebound action plan along with Bank Guarantee. (Action by: Process Houses, timeline: 15.04.2027)

Logistics and GPS Tracking: RO Bhilwara shall incorporate a GPS tracking feature in the monitoring portal in consultation with M/s Ramky Enviro Services for waste transportation vehicles. Vendors must ensure leak-proof vehicles to prevent spillage on roads. (Action by: RO Bhilwara/GIC-IT)

Inspection and Sampling: Regional Officer, Bhilwara is directed to conduct random inspections of transporter vehicles and carry out sampling to verify moisture content compliance as per prescribed frequency. (Action by: RO Bhilwara)

Monsoon Preparedness: Vendors are directed to lift all hazardous waste by the end of June. Process houses must develop onsite storage capacity for at least 90 days. (Action by: All Vendors and Industries, timeline: 30.06.2026)

Authorization Modification: The Board will review the request to allow disposal through pre-processing units subject to the 60:40 ratio and Office Order dated 17.12.2021. (Action by: ACEE-CETP/Planning)

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
